Introduction:

Clause 4.2.1.(c) of the Australian Karate Federation Limited (AKF) constitution requires a Member organisation to ensure that relevant categories of persons associated with the Organisation as determined by the Board are registered with the Company as Individual Members;

This policy sets out the relevant categories of persons associated with the organisation / club, applying for membership to the Australian Karate Federation of the Australian Karate Federation Limited (AKF)

In terms of clause 4.3.6 "The Board may develop and implement additional Policies including membership criteria to be met by Members from time to time"

About

The AKF has a significant and important responsibility to *regulate, conduct, encourage, promote, advance, control and manage all levels and disciplines of Karate in Australia* and in doing so develops and adopts policies, processes and procedures that delivers on this responsibility.

Accordingly, AKF Membership connects all involved in the sport under the AKF banner and ensures that the activities and conduct of all members is captured under karate's policy framework and aligns to AKF and community expectations.

Scope

This document applies to member clubs and their nominated voting member, who is responsible to ensure compliance with this policy.

Policy

The board has determined that the relevant categories of persons associated with the organisation are defined as all students, instructors, and other participants of a member organisation / club.
